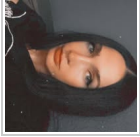

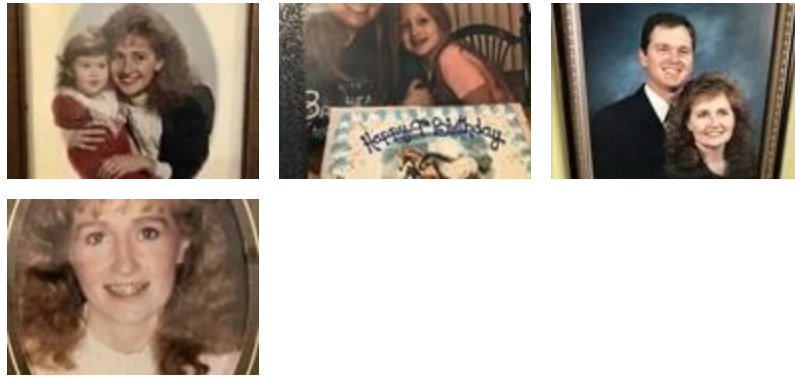

Christmas morning we celebrated Jesus' birthday and Christmas evening, we celebrated Angela's birthday.
