



Calvin Elias Stuck

August 23, 1931 - October 16, 2015

Calvin E. Stuck, age 84, of New Glarus, formerly of Brodhead, passed away on Friday, October 16, 2015, at The New Glarus Home, New Glarus, WI. He was born on August 23, 1931 in Harvey, IL, the son of Everett D. and Mildred (Abrams) Stuck. He married Rosemary Burwitz on March 21, 1959. She passed away on May 1, 2010. Calvin lived in Illinois, moving to Streator, IL in 1938 where he attended school. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1950-1954 on the ship the USS Beatty 756, giving support to the United Nations Ground Forces, 8th Army, in Korea and Task Force 77. Following his tour of duty, he attended the LeTourneau Technical Institute, Longview, TX in 1956. Calvin was also a member of the Brodhead VFW Post 6858.
