previously held positions in landscaping, concrete and sealcoating. Devin's meaning of hard work and love transformed with the birth of his daughter Delilah "Woogie". He was forever changed and made a commitment to strive to be the best father and provider for his children. He was ecstatic to learn of his son Jaxton's arrival in July 2020. Devin's outgoing nature made it easy for him to make his way in this world. He enjoyed coffee runs while cruising and listening to music with his sisters. Always lending a helping hand or jumping in to offer kind words and support to others. Devin will be remembered for his infectious smile, courageous heart, and one day at a time attitude.
