



## Dorothy Jane (Hulburt) Porterfield

June 5, 1918 - January 15, 2013

Brodhead - Dorothy Jane Porterfield, age 94, of rural Brodhead, passed away on Tuesday, January 15, 2013, at Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe. She was born on June 5, 1918 in Sylvester Township, the daughter of Dewey and Ida (Malkow) Hulburt. She married Carlyle Porterfield on April 1, 1936 in Galena, Illinois.
