Elmo P. Earleywine, age 86, of Brodhead, passed away on Tuesday, June 17, 2014, at Woods Crossing Nursing Home, Brodhead. He was born on January 29, 1928 in Milton, WI, the son of Guy B. and Stella E. (Albright) Earleywine. He married Janette ❖Jan❖ Shew on June 14, 1949 in Milwaukee, WI. They recently celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary. Elmo graduated from Brodhead High School in 1945 and the University of Wisconsin - Madison in 1950 with a degree in electrical engineering. He enjoyed woodworking and his greatest accomplishment was building a 25 ft. yawl sailboat.
