Greg L. Pryce, age 64, of Brodhead, passed away on Friday, December 6, 2013, at Mercy Hospital, Janesville. He was born on July 27, 1949 in Monroe, WI, the son of William and Marilyn (Flora) Pryce. He married Cindy Olson on August 1, 1970 in Albany, WI. Greg graduated from Albany High School in 1967 and was a member of the Albany United Methodist Church.
