Brodhead – Harold Roy Schultz, age 89, passed away on February 23, 2022 while at St. Mary’s Hospital in Madison.

Harold was born on January 22, 1933 in South Beloit, IL the son of Vernon Schultz and Elsie (Jensen) Cowell. Harold was a Brodhead High School graduate in 1951. He served in the US Navy during the Korean War Conflict from 1952-1953. After Harold’s service, he married Joyce Schneider on March 15, 1953. She passed away in 1977. He later married Wanda Mize on February 14, 1984 and she passed away in 2001.

Harold worked for Osborn Plumbing and Heating for many years and then later for the Pipe Fitters Union Local No. 601 before his retirement at 65.
