### Obituary

Harry L. Nye, age 75, of Brodhead, formerly of Oregon/Brooklyn area, passed away on Monday, April 16, 2018, at his home. He was born on June 2, 1942 in Stoughton, WI, the son of Harry and Irene (Harstad) Nye.

Harry had been a Dane County Traffic Police officer for 31 years. The Traffic Police merged with the Dane County Sheriff's Dept. in 1981 and Harry then became a deputy sheriff, retiring in 1998.
