



## Jean M. (Smith) Earleywine

January 17, 1919 - November 20, 2015

Jean M. Earleywine, age 96, of Freeport, IL, formerly of Juda, WI, passed away on Friday, November 20, 2015, at her home. She was born on January 17, 1919 in Cumberland, WI, the daughter of Roy and Blanche (Westgate) Smith. She married Judd D. Earleywine on April 13, 1945 at Ft. Benning, GA.
