August 31, 1943 - September 13, 2014

Lyle G. Hilliard, age 71, of Albany, formerly of Brodhead, passed away on September 13, 2014 at Park Valley Assisted Living, Albany, WI, following a long, courageous battle with cancer. He was born on August 31, 1943 in Monroe, WI, the son of Shirl and Hazel (Prien) Hilliard. He grew-up on a farm on Middle Juda Road and attended grade and high school in Juda, graduating in 1961.
