Matthew W. McCarville, age 56, of Brodhead, passed away on Sunday, May 26, 2013, at his home, following a battle with ALS. He was born on July 28, 1956 in Rockford, IL, the son of Michael P. and Marilyn (McKittrick) McCarville. He married Mary Jo Silver on October 3, 1981 at St. Victor Catholic Church, Monroe, WI. Matt graduated from Beloit Catholic High School in 1975 and worked for Alliant Energy for over 30 years. He was a member of the Lions Club and Sports Boosters, both of Brodhead, and was also a former member of the Decatur Lake Golf Course. Matt enjoyed teaching weightlifting, playing cards and pool, but his true love was coaching youth sports. He was an avid Brodhead Cardinal fan.
