



Sue M (Emerson) Batari

November 13, 1941 - April 15, 2012

Brodhead - Sue M. Batari, age 70, of Brodhead, died of cancer on Sunday, April 15, 2012 at her home, surrounded by loved ones. She was born on November 13, 1941 in Beloit, WI, the daughter of Michael and Sue (Beecher) Emerson. She married Laszlo Batari on May 10, 1985. He passed away on September 30, 2007. Sue and her husband, Laszlo, were the owners of a group home/mental health out patient clinic for teenage girls called the House of Samuel, Orfordville, WI. The house was named after their son Samuel, who was killed at age 17 by a drunk driver. After the love of her life, Laszlo, passed in 2007, Sue obtained her Chaplaincy through I.F.O.C. She began doing various works helping others through charity and counseling. Sue enjoyed spending time with family and friends, laughing, riding horses, traveling, listening to music, and contributing to her community. Survivors included three children; Amy Emerson of South Dakota, Sarah (Todd) Bolen of Brodhead, WI and Niko Laszlo Batari of Beloit, WI; grandchildren, Sedona, Dylan and Sam; great-grandchildren, Leah, Israel and Colton; a sister, Rhoda Walters, Edgerton, WI, and several nieces, nephews and other family and friends. She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, sisters, Ramona Emerson and Nancy Rogenholt, and a son, Samuel. Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m., Thursday, April 19, 2012, at Luther Valley Church, rural Beloit, WI, with Rev. Larry Froemming officiating. Burial will be in Luther Valley Cemetery. Visitation will be held from 1 p.m., Thursday, until time of services at the church. ❖
