Brodhead - Vincent E. Olson, age 92, of Brodhead, passed away on Wednesday, March 27, 2013, at his daughter's home in Beloit. He was born on January 24, 1921 in Rock County, WI, the son of Hervin and Ella (Eggen) Olson. He married Rosabel F. Lunde on April 23, 1941 in Monroe, WI. She passed away on April 4, 2012. Vince was the Brodhead Postmaster for many years, retiring in 1981. His first love was farming, which he enjoyed his entire life. He also loved the outdoors, all sports, and especially gardening. He was a member of Bethlehem Lutheran Church, American Legion, VFW Post 6858, all of Brodhead. He was a World War II Army Veteran and received the Victory Medal, Bronze Star, and the American-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal. He is survived by four children, Dennis (Mary) Olson, Madison, WI, Vickie (Richard) Caple, Vincent ♦Kirk♦(Mary) Olson, both of Beloit, Peter (Laurie) Olson, Brodhead; fourteen grandchildren, twenty-three great-grandchildren, and two great great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, wife, two brothers, Howard and Roger ♦Bud♦ Olson, and a sister, Clarice Demrow. Funeral services will be held at 11:30 a.m., Monday, April 1, 2013, at the Bethlehem Lutheran Church, Brodhead, with Pastor Peder Johanson officiating.
